Please guide your child through referring to the procedures below:

-  Select a theme and a keyword you want to draw.
 - ✓ An artwork must concern at least one of the suggested keywords.
-  Look up the internet, documentaries, and books for getting information on the selected keyword.
-  Express your story in drawing about the selected theme and keyword.

SPECIFICATIONS

- 1) Eligibility: Children aged 4 through 12 (born between 2011 and 2019)
- 2) Application period: **July 03 ~ July 30, 2023**
- 3) Paper size: A square piece of drawing paper (250mm x 250mm or bigger)
- 4) Drawing materials: No restrictions

Note Digital artwork and drawing with text (such as posters) are not accepted.
- 5) How to apply: Online (Visit the contest website: <http://kidsart.hil.or.kr/>)
- 6) Winner announcement: August 16, 2023 (to be announced on the contest website)

JUDGING

Item	Explanation	Criteria
First Judging	The first judging will select a certain number of excellent drawings.	<p>Is the artwork appropriate for child development stages?</p> <p>Isn't the artwork overly guided by a teacher or others?</p> <p>Is it possible the artwork indicates the teaching direction on marine environment conservation?</p> <p>Does the artwork express a child's sincerity? (Especially, in terms of drawing and painting)</p> <p>Does the artwork include the child's creative characters?</p>
Second Judging	Awards will be determined from the selected drawings. by members of the Judging Committee.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Appropriateness: Does the artwork correspond with the theme? - Creativity: Does the artwork have individuality making itself different from others? - Expressiveness: Does the artwork express the applicant's thoughts well? - Pureness: Does a child's own pureness stand out vividly in the artwork?

HOW TO APPLY

1) Select one of the themes and the keywords and plan out your artwork.

2) Express your thoughts on a **square** piece of drawing paper. (250mm x 250mm or bigger)

(Note 1) A **square** piece of paper: the width and the length of the paper are the same.

(Note 2) Drawing materials: No restrictions.

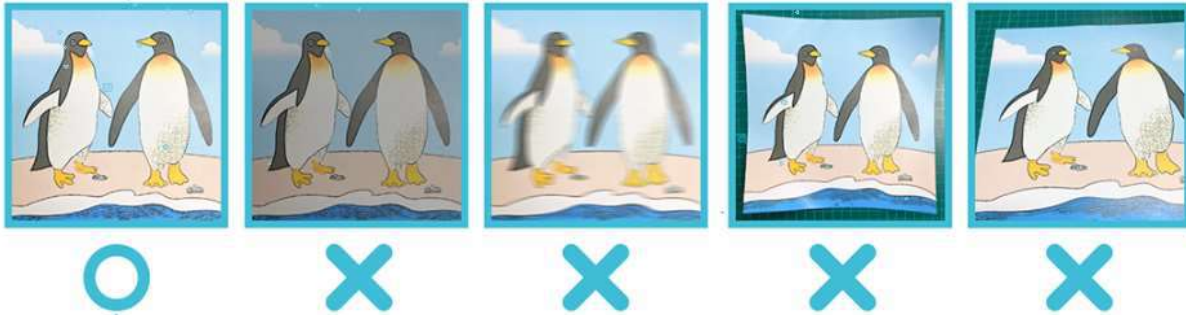
(Note 3) Digital artwork and drawing with text (such as posters) are not accepted.

3) Take a digital image (.jpg, .jpeg, .png) of your drawing (by digital camera or smartphone or scanner)

(Note 1) Photograph your drawing in the light without shaking (in the case of using a digital camera or smartphone)

(Note 2) The digital image should be a high-resolution photo less than 5MB.

(Note 3) The whole painting should be shown in the image.



4. Visit the contest website <http://kidsart.hil.or.kr/> and apply for the contest
(Note 1) Fill in your information and introduction paragraph (in English only)
(Note 2) The way of naming your digital image: ‘**Your name_The title of your artwork.**’
(ex. ‘**John Adams_A festival of whales**’)
5. Keep your original drawing Clean.
6. Send the original drawings to KMFRI address below not later than **4th August 2023**:

Note The eventual winner will be confirmed after checking the original drawing by HUMAN IN LOVE.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- ✚ Only one artwork per child is allowed to submit to the contest.
- ✚ The artwork should be a creation of the applicant himself (or herself). All artwork overly guided by a teacher, parents, or others will be eliminated at the first judging.
- ✚ If the judging committee figures out your drawing has any problem to be awarded, such as a copyright infringement, you will be disqualified from the winner.
- ✚ If your drawing is an imitation (such as prize-winner artwork from other contests, artwork published in textbooks, newspapers, magazines, etc.), you will be disqualified from the winner.
- ✚ Artworks containing violence or sensationalism will be excluded from the judging.
- ✚ You must draw on a square piece of paper (the width and length of the paper should be the same). If your drawing is on a rectangular piece of paper, it may bring

disadvantages to you. We will randomly capture only a part of the drawing as a square-sized for the judging.

- ✚ If your artwork is selected as a candidate for the winner, HUMAN IN LOVE(HIL) will contact you.
- ✚ Your Original work (art) sent to **Kenya Marine and Fisheries Research Institute** will then be submitted to HIL. (If you don't submit the original artwork, you will be disqualified from the winner).
- ✚ All the submitted artwork will belong to HUMAN IN LOVE(HIL), in terms of ownership and copyright. HIL can use them as promotional materials for the marine environment conservation campaign after modifying them for the purpose.
